Clay is the ultimate plastic chameleon. In the hands of Kansas City artist Robin Beard it is the medium defined by a succession of conscious and artful cataclysms. Seemingly left to natural forces Beard's complex surfaces offer a record of explosive activity.

In another series of work Beard pushes the boundaries again by creating three-dimensional linear drawings in clay from extruded forms. Born in Manzanillo, Mexico in 1974, Beard came to Kansas City to attend the Kansas City Art Institute receiving his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Sculpture in 1999. This is Robin Beard's first solo exhibition at Dolphin.
